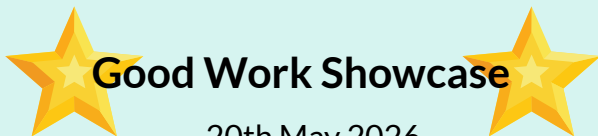
In School This Week...
